The Story

Like the Wind is a new musical that explores the lives of Bennie and Cai, two queer teenagers running away from a conversion therapy facility in the summer of 2018. Told partially in flashback, Bennie and Cai choose to change the fate that society has set for them and break through the constraints of expectations and rules. With a queer writing team at the helm, Like the Wind explores themes of identity, forgiveness, and queerness in young people.



Elspeth Collard (she/her) is an award-winning British-born composer, orchestrator, music director, and educator. Theatrical works include: Like The Wind (SoHo Playhouse, 2023; The Brick Theatre 2021); ROSE (NYU 2021); A Princess Story (Marymount Manhattan College 2023); Twenty-Six Percent (EAT Festival 2022); Miroir (NYU 2020); Easier To Die (NYU 2019); and Don't Ever Change (Edinburgh Fringe and Brickhouse Theatre, Cambridge, 2017).

Short films include An Intimate Moment (2022; Official Selection, New York Movie Awards); That Little Moment When (2022; Best Composer Award and Official Selection, Amsterdam International Film Festival), Roomies (2021), New Year's Eve (2021), and Nice To Meet You Again (2020; Official Selection, Venice Shorts Festival, New York Movie Awards).

With collaborator Sam Rosenblatt, she has two albums available on all major streaming services: Little Love Notes (2021) and Collisions: A Concept Album (2023). Her songs and orchestrations have been featured at cabaret venues including Feinstein's/54 Below, The Green Room 42, Dixon Place, The Duplex, and Don't Tell Mama.

Elspeth has also worked as a percussionist and music director on a number of concerts and productions based out of Cambridge, Edinburgh, and New York, including the original Edinburgh Fringe run of Six. She is a graduate of NYU Tisch (MFA, Musical Theatre Writing) and Newnham College, University of Cambridge (BA, Music), and a proud member of Maestra, ASCAP, and the Dramatists Guild.

Sam is a curator and producer for *Tin Pan Alley 2*, a Core Team Member for *Root Beer Occasion Theatre Company*, and an Artistic Director for *The Latest Draft* podcast. A wearer of many hats, Sam also enjoys stage-managing, props design, graphic design, and sock-puppet-making. She is a proud member of the Dramatists Guild, ASCAP, and Maestra.

CAI'S MOTHER	40's and scared. Judgemental. Straight. Doubles as FARRAH and ADULT WOMAN. Soprano.
